

About the newly updated Safety Training for Loggers

In order to better serve the logging community, the SFI Committee under Texas Forestry Association has developed a new Safety Training program. The new program will be offered LIVE and then online in early 2012.

How often do you take Safety Training? Safety Training must be taken every two years.

Who should take Safety training? All logging contractors and employees.

Here's a look at what you can expect:

- (1) An in-depth look at OSHA rules and regulations by Jim Shelton, U.S. Department of Labor, OSHA
 - Why preventing injuries and illnesses is important for business and employees
 - Logging Accident Overview
 - Overview OSHA Logging Standards
 - Overview Common OSHA Required Safety Programs
 - Personal Protective Equipment

- (2) Compliance – Safety – Accountability, by Eddie Prather, Director of Safety, Fleetwood Transportation
 - CSA 2010 Safety Measurement System (SMS) Performance-based for determining motor carrier and driver safety –Identifying entities for interventions
 - Measures safety performance using all roadside inspection safety-based violations
 - Weights time and severity of violations based on relationship to crash risk
 - Calculates safety performance in 7 Behavior Analysis and Safety Improvement Categories (BASIC'S)
 - Support FMCSA's Safety Fitness Determination

- (3) Equipment Safety by Ed Glover, Manager, Mustang Tractor & Equipment Co.
 - General logging safety
 - Site safety
 - Machine specific safety procedures
 - Proper use of manuals that should be supplied with machines and how to read them

- (4) How to Be Safe when using small tools
 - Operator Fitness
 - Proper Clothing & PPE
 - Proper use of Tools
 - Work Area
 - Tool Maintenance

- (5) Cell Phone Safety in the Workplace and On the Road, by Lanny Dreesen, Consultant
