**WHERE: Eastman Nature Center, Longview TX**

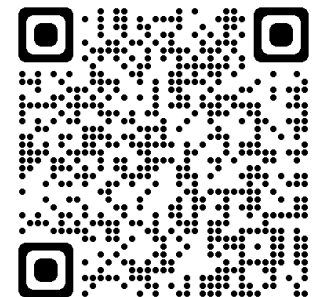
